

Victorian Child Safe Standards Training

Designed by practitioners for practitioners



The Victorian Child Safe Standards require organisations involving children to have policies, procedures, and practices to keep them safe. Organisations that provide services or facilities for children must implement Child Safe Standards to protect them from abuse. This workshop features a presentation on these standards and gives participants an understanding of what is required to implement them.

This engaging 3-hour workshop provides participants with an opportunity to reflect on the strengths of their organisation and identify areas requiring attention. Participants will be able to ask questions and delve into issues relevant to their organisation during the session.

The workshop can be delivered either online or face to face. To optimise the learning experience and maximise opportunities for learner participation, audience capacity is 30 participants per session.

Learning Outcomes

- What is needed to implement the 11 Child Safe Standards, including obligations and responsibilities overview.
- How to focus on the safety and wellbeing of First Nations children.
- How to build safety and wellbeing for diverse children and families.
- Reflect on what an organisation is doing well and identify areas that require attention, and
- Where to access specialised resources for implementing the standards.

Child Safe Standards eLearn Module (~1 hour)

This interactive eLearn module created by the Centre is a great alternative to or pre-requisite for a Child Safe Standards Workshop. The eLearn module informs participants of each of the 11 Standards currently in place and helps individuals understand what measures they can take to help their organisation be compliant with the standards. Key features:

- Understand all 11 Child Safe Standards and the role of the Commission for Children and Young People (CCYP).
- Checklists to help individuals and organisations implement each standard.
- Interactive activities and videos.
- Further reading and key resources.
- Quizzes to test your knowledge.

Who should attend the workshop and/or complete the eLearn:

Anyone who is responsible for the care of children and keeping children safe. Directors and individuals who are responsible for ensuring their organisation is compliant to the Child Safe Standards.
